

8. Review Colossians 2:13-14. Highlight the phrases in verse 14 that assure us that Christ’s resurrection confirms God’s forgiveness of our sins.


¹³“And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;
