#### 1 Kings 15:9-14

- **9** And in the twentieth year of Jeroboam king of Israel reigned Asa over Judah.
- **10** And forty and one years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Maachah, the daughter of Abishalom.
- **11** And Asa did that which was right in the eyes of the LORD, as did David his father.
- **12** And he took away the sodomites out of the land, and removed all the idols that his fathers had made.
- **13** And also Maachah his mother, even her he removed from being queen, because she had made an idol in a grove; and Asa destroyed her idol, and burnt it by the brook Kidron.
- **14** But the high places were not removed: nevertheless Asa's heart was perfect with the LORD all his days.

- **2** And Asa did that which was good and right in the eyes of the LORD his God:
- **3** For he took away the altars of the strange gods, and the high places, and brake down the images, and cut down the groves:
- **4** And commanded Judah to seek the LORD God of their fathers, and to do the law and the commandment.
- **5** Also he took away out of all the cities of Judah the high places and the images: and the kingdom was quiet before him.
- **6** And he built fenced cities in Judah: for the land had rest, and he had no war in those years; because the LORD had given him rest.
- **7** Therefore he said unto Judah, Let us build these cities, and make about them walls, and towers, gates, and bars, while the land is yet before us; because we have sought the LORD our God, we have sought him, and he hath given us rest on every side. So they built and prospered.
